CNAI: HS diploma/GED not required, but you must take the CASAS reading test or supply documentation such as college placement test scores or a college transcript for exemption from the test. The CASAS test is free and will be given by appointment only. Morning, afternoon, and evening classes.

CNAII: Before we can accept a name for the interest list, you must have a HS Diploma / GED, and be a certified Nurse Aide I, listed on the NC Nurse Aide Registry in good standing. Classes are normally held on Tuesday & Thursday mornings, 8:30 am - 12:30 pm.

CNAI: You do not have to possess a HS diploma/GED, but you must pass a free CASAS reading test or supply documentation such as college placement test scores or a college transcript for exemption before your name can be placed on the waiting list. The 30-minute test is offered from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m. and 5-7:30 p.m. Tuesdays only.

CNAII: Must have HS diploma/GED; listed on the NC Nurse Aide I Registry; and pass a NAI competency pre-test given at ICC-Polk.

Phlebotomy: Must have HS diploma/GED; reading and math comprehension tests required before you can be placed on the waiting list. The 30-minute test is offered from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m. and 5-7:30 p.m. Tuesdays only.

Curriculum Classes: Must apply for admission, take placement tests and submit HS/GED and college transcripts.

CNAI: morning, afternoon and evening classes during fall and spring semesters; CNAI refresher offered in the summer.

CNAII: day and evening classes during fall and spring semesters

Phlebotomy: evening only for two semesters - classroom in fall semester; clinicals in spring semester

CNAI: HS diploma/GED not required, but must apply for admission, take reading placement test and meet minimum score. Must provide original social security card and government-issued picture ID (name must exactly match social security card). Day, afternoon, evening sections.

CNAII: Must have HS diploma/GED and submit transcripts, apply for admission, take reading and pre-algebra placement test and meet minimum required score, be listed on the NC Nurse Aide I registry. Morning and evening sections.

Phlebotomy: Must have HS diploma/GED; must provide documentation of complete immunization records. Evening classes through Continuing Education, 828-652-0662.

CNAI: Must be 18 years of age; copy of valid driver's license and Social Security card with matching names; HS diploma/GED; American Heart Association CPR certified prior to the start of class; completion of TABE test with a 9th grade score on reading and math (to schedule TABE testing, please call (828) 438-6131 for an appointment).

CNAII: HS diploma/GED; current listing as a Nurse Aide I; CPR certifications; six months working experience as a Nurse Aide I; letter of recommendation from immediate supervisor.

Phlebotomy: Copy of valid driver's license and Social Security card with matching names; HS diploma/GED.
