

**Campus Life Taskforce  
Minutes – 03/11/08 2:15 p.m.**

The Campus Life Taskforce met on Tuesday, March 11th at 2:15 p.m. in room 12 of the Student Center Building. Those present were: Lisa Bridges, Brett Watson, Kimberly Snyder, Tina Porter, Terry McEntire, Engle Troxler, Carson Thomas, Tiffany Cooper, and John Kiser.

The committee went over final preparations for Sports Day, scheduled for April 17, 2008. Brett will be responsible for setting up the informational table covering China to promote global awareness. He will provide a basket filled with items having a Chinese connection to be given as a prize. Individuals who answer a short quiz about China along with a few survey questions needed by the Global Awareness Committee will be eligible for the prize drawing. He will also provide a red table covering decorated with yellow stars to go along with the China theme.

Kimberly will order fortune cookies from the SGA budget to put on the table for student consumption. She has ordered mechanical swings and an inflatable obstacle course for Sports Day as activities designed to go along with the China theme. Kimberly, Tina and SGA members will make posters to connect the swings and obstacle course with Chinese culture. Kimberly will pick up ping pong tables from Judy Roberson and Myra Johnson and deliver them to campus for use on Sports Day. Finally, Kimberly will ask Mike Lipkin if he would like to do a Tae Kwon Do demonstration.

The committee discussed scheduling health screenings from 8:00 to 10:00 a.m. with vendors scheduled from 10:00 to 3:00 p.m. Terry is calling: Plum Natural, Therasage, and Danielle Rogers about participating. The target audience will be Isothermal students and employees, community members, hospital representatives, and local high school students. Maintenance will be asked to help with the set-up of the gym. Refreshments for vendors will be provided by the committee or donated. The committee was asked to bring names of people and/or businesses to invite to participate in the fair to the next meeting and encourage them to bring a door prize. Tiffany will contact Mike Gavin to see what he has available for promotional items.
