

Campus Life Taskforce

Minutes – 3/07/07 2:30 p.m.

The Campus Life Taskforce met on Wednesday, March 7th at 2:30 p.m. in the Business Sciences Building, Red Room. Those present were Cindy Martin, Terry McEntire, Tina Porter, Kimberly Snyder, Lisa Bridges, Susan Foster, David Libera, Engle Troxler, Carol Lattimore and Stephen Matheny.

Terry McEntire suggested that the committee purchase some “Interpersonal Skills” and “It’s Never Too Late for Adult Learners” pamphlets with a portion of this year’s budget. It was suggested that 50 of each pamphlet be purchased at a cost of \$1.19 each. More could be ordered later if they proved to be popular. These pamphlets would be distributed in each building. The ACA Committee might also be interested in these.

It was reported that the pedometers had been given out to others for testing. To date there has been no additional feedback. Cindy asked that an update be obtained in order to decide if the pedometers should be available to be checked out to the campus at large.

Susan Foster reported on the status of the March of Dimes, *WalkAmerica* scheduled for April 21. Currently, the team captains are Kim Gold, Sandra Boyd (PTL), Cindy Martin, Mike Gavin, Susan Foster and Ashley Day. It was suggested that each team captain recruit at least ten walkers. Registration on the day of the walk begins at 9:00 a.m. with the walk commencing at 10:00. Registration is also available online at walkamerica.org. Susan distributed a pamphlet to the committee members present. A jump off rally is planned in two weeks. Carol Lattimore will find out if the bookstore could sell beanie-babies to raise money. It was suggested that the granddaughter of Earl Campbell be asked to be the team ambassador. Susan will put up posters to promote the event in the near future. The committee was encouraged to recruit team members and raise as much money as possible.

Kimberly Snyder gave a report on Sports Day scheduled for April 25th. To date, the vendors and planned events have not been finalized. Suggested activities are volleyball (staff vs. students), tug-of-war, turtle race, and relay races. She asked that the Campus Life Taskforce help with the tug-of-war and volley ball sign-ups and execution. It was suggested that the tug-of-war be billed as a “re-match” with a few additional teams as organized as challengers. The winners from Grub Day could present the trophy to the new winners. It was suggested that a promotional email go out the last week in March with a reminder sent out the first week in April. Terry McEntire will take care of faculty/staff volleyball signups and Cindy Martin will take care of tug-of-war. Engle asked that the email also be sent to “thelearningcollege.org.”

The remainder of the meeting was spent discussing the “Healthy Lunch” planned for April 5, 2007 in the Maple Room from 11:00 to 1:00. The time will be split into two sittings of 25 people each. The first 50 people responding to the invitation will be served. The committee members present along with a few special guests will also be served for a total of 60 people. Stephen Matheny will purchase all food supplies from the ICC

Annual Fund. Ingredients and amounts needed for each recipe should be forwarded to Stephen for inclusion in the purchase order. Engle Troxler will organize the recipes to be printed to include the nutritional information for each dish. These will be distributed at the event. Susan Foster will furnish the plates from the Foundation. Cindy Martin will check the Maple Room for silverware and serving dishes. Lisa Bridges will send out the invitations on March 26, 2007.
