

Campus Life Taskforce Meeting: November 12, 2003

The meeting was brought to order at 1:30 by Audrey Sherrill in the Student Conference Room of building 10. In attendance were: Audrey Sherrill (Chairperson), Kristi Sanborn (Vice Chairperson), Lisa Bridges, Karen Jones, Scott Scheer, and Sandra Boyd.

The following items were discussed:

1. Audrey handed out the results of the CLT Crisis Intervention Subcommittee survey on how faculty deal with students problems. We agreed that enough information was present in the surveys to present the issue to TALC. Audrey will follow up.
2. The Top Health Newsletter was discussed. An order for 100 (?) was placed for October and November, however the company only sent 50 copies of each. Audrey is working with the publisher/suppliers to sort out the problem.
3. Johnny Smith is presenting his talk "The Grind" to ACA classes and at the foundation, seminar A on November 19 at 9:00 and 11:00 am.
4. Kristi presented information about the tennis courts and weight room per her conversation with Mike Crousorre. According to Mike, requests to fix the weight room have been numerous, to no avail. The nets can be fixed at any time, and resurfacing of the courts would need to be sent out on bid and approved by TALC. We resolved to take these matters up with TALC to help get the ball rolling, though Audrey mentioned most of the budget for these types of repairs will be spent on the Library roof.
5. Audrey Sherrill will be leaving ICC! A reception in her honor will be held on Dec. 1 from 2-3:30 pm in the lobby of building 10. Audrey gave Kristi all materials for CLT.
6. Kristi brought up that the food and music at the annual holiday dinner doesn't necessarily reflect the diversity of religions and food/health choices of faculty and staff. It was suggested that those concerned speak to Dr. Lewis.
7. Kristi brought up her frustrations with being part of a team. We teach our students the importance of being team players, however many of us were never taught how. Karen told us about a book by John Maxwell called, "17 Qualities of a Team Player" being studied by her department. Myra will be using it for her department next. It was suggested that the book be circulated to all departments to help faculty and staff better understand how to be a part of a team.
