### Continued Business:

- 3<sup>rd</sup> Annual Old Fashioned Family Fall Festival

    - Volunteers to get there 30 minutes early to setup
  - RSVP date is Monday, October 12<sup>th</sup>
  - Budget (Cindy to ask)
  - Food – same supper as last year; Cindy will shop for the food: hot dogs, buns, chips, condiments, onions, drinks, apples
  - Volunteers to bring:

    - Dessert – invitation to mention that any guest may bring a dessert
  - Decorations – same as last year: anyone can bring pumpkins, hay, other fall items
