Framework was made as simple as possible for easy navigation. The topics include:

- Cooperative learning
- Learning styles
- Multiple intelligences
- Brain-based learning
- Concept maps
- Learning focused instruction
- Bloom's taxonomy
- Distance learning

The framework was built in such a way to allow additional topics to be easily added to the moodle site. You can post links or discussion to the different topics. The purpose of the discussion threads is to make comments or ask questions. The links section allows you to link to Web sites for particular topics. Every section will include both links and discussions. Rick Childress has control over the topics, but any one enrolled in the course can post a link or discussion. No key is needed to enroll into the course. User's can request postings to be forwarded automatically to email.

Suggested to add all ICC documentation and pertinent paper work, lesson plans, etc. to the site. This idea is still under review. Rick and Ashley received approval from the LSTF to continue work on the current framework.
