MINUTES OF TRUSTEES' MEETING - ISOTHERMAL COMMUNITY COLLEGE TUESDAY, FEBRUARY 14, 1967

The Trustees of Isothermal Community College met for their quarterly meeting at 6:00 P. M. on February 14, 1967, at the National Guard Armory. The following members were present: Ivy Cowan, Dr. W. M. Elliott, Spencer Gamble, Dr. J. T. Mize, Max Padgett, Robert Spratt, James Tanner, Clyde Tomblin, and the President, Fred J. Eason.

The Vice Chairman, James Tanner, called the meeting to order and the minutes of the last meeting were approved.

The action of the Executive Committee was reported as follows:

The Executive Committee of Isothermal Community College met on December 12, 1966, at 12 o'clock at the National Guard Armory. All members of the committee were present. The President requested authorization to submit an application for \$110,965.00 in Appalachia funds for the completion of the building project (No. NC-3-1582). A motion was made and seconded and passed unanimously. The President was directed to submit the necessary forms, after which the meeting was adjourned.

This action was approved by the unanimous vote of the Trustees.

Mr. Ivy Cowan, chairman of the Building Committee, gave a report on the progress of the construction. The work was reported to be progressing at a satisfactory rate.

The Trustees discussed the sewer service to the college site. Since a joint engineering survey by the towns of Spindale and Forest City has been proposed, it was decided that the Board would delay any action
