September 27, 1974



The Building Committee of Isothermal Community College met in the board room at 11 a.m. September 27, 1974. Present were J.J. Tarlton, Mike Davis, Ivy Cowan, Jimmy Tanner, Max Padgett, Stover Dunagan, Lena Mayberry, Fred Eason and Ralph Porter.

President Eason stated that the purpose of the meeting was to report to the committee what had been done and to get suggestions for the bond campaign. Since there are only five weeks left to get the idea across to the public it is necessary that action be taken.

A copy of the suggested advertising budget in the amount of \$2,000. was given each member. Mr. Dunagan outlined a program that he felt would be helpful in getting the public to vote for the bond issue. He reported that all the Civic and Service Clubs in the county had been contacted informing them that speakers would be available beginning the first week in October with information concerning the bond issue. A slide-tape program has been developed which will run ten minutes. This program will be presented first to the students and faculty of ICC. The President of the Student Body is encouraging students and faculty to register if they have not already done so. A brochure is being prepared to use as a hand-out to groups where the slide-tape programs are given and to mail out. Ads are to be published in the local papers and local radio stations will have spots concerning the bond election.

The following action was taken: The motion was made and seconded that the program as outlined by Mr. Dunagan be accepted and that the people who have the authority be allowed to spend the \$2,000. as outlined in the advertising budget for the bond campaign.

The meeting was adjourned.
