ISOTHERMAL COMMUNITY COLLEGE BUILDING COMMITTEE FEBRUARY 7, 1977

The Building Committee of Isothermal Community College met in the Learning Resources Center at 4:00 p.m., February 7, 1977. Present were: Chairman Ivy Cowan, James Tanner, Joe Miller, Mike Davis, Max Padgett and President Fred J. Eason, Ralph Porter and Dr. David Daniel of the college staff.

The following action was taken:

1. Adaville Church Cemetery

In response to a request from the cemetery committee for a portion of the college land adjoining the cemetery, the committee directed President Eason to inform the proper church officials that the college does not wish to dispose of any property. The college offers to the church free access to the cemetery by using any portion of the college property between the cemetery and the fence marking the college property line, with the understanding that since service lines to the college are located in that vicinity, the college retains the right to have access to these lines whenever necessary.

2. Addition To The Gymnasium

The Building Committee approved, in substance, a plan submitted by Architect Leslie Boney, to enclose and roof a section of approximately 5600 sq. ft. at the southwest corner of the gymnasium, making whatever changes in exterior walls as may be necessary. The committee directed the college officials to have the Architect proceed with plans and specifications for the approval of the Board of Trustees.

3. Physical Education Field Grading

The committee directed the President and the Business Manager to call for bids as soon as possible on the grading of the 24.6 acres directly across Piney Ridge Road from the main campus. Two bids are to be submitted by grading contractors; one for the entire grading job according to specifications prepared by Mallonee Surveying, Inc., and the other for the grading of only approximately 11 acres adjoining Piney Ridge Road.

4. Additional Toilets and Office Space In The Learning Resources Center

After much discussion about the feasibility of building two toilets to the rear of the Learning Resources Center, and the creation of an office for the Learning Lab Director, the committee concluded that not enough information was available, and that this matter should be discussed with the Architect at his next visit on February 22.

5. Meeting With Architect

The committee agreed to meet with the Architect on February 22 to discuss these and any other suitable matters.
