## ISOTHERMAL COMMUNITY COLLEGE MEETING OF BOARD OF TRUSTEES SEPTEMBER 21, 1988 MINUTES

The Isothermal Community College Board of Trustees met on Wednesday, September 21, 1988, in the Management Seminar Room of the Business Education Building.

W. McCall, Sr., Peter Hahn and Jim Rutledge, President of the Polk County Campus Foundation. Chairman Arledge called the meeting to order.

Mr. Arledge stated that the purpose of the called meeting was to review and to consider awarding the proposed contracts to the low bidders for the Polk campus facility.

After a thorough review and discussion of the proposed contracts, a motion was made by J.D. Cooley and seconded by Opal Sauve, which reads as follows:

"I move that we accept the low bids as negotiated for the Polk County campus. The awarding of these contracts is contingent upon having the necessary funds in hand by 4:30 p.m., September 30. I further move that should the necessary funds not be in hand by September 30, the Board of Trustees of Isothermal Community College authorize the President of the college to reject all bids."
