ISOTHERMAL COMMUNITY COLLEGE JOINT MEETING OF BOARD OF TRUSTEES AND RUTHERFORD COUNTY COMMISSIONERS MAY 15, 2007

A joint meeting between the Isothermal Community College Board of Trustees and the Rutherford County Commissioners was held on Tuesday, May 15, 2007, at the Rutherford County Annex at 11:30 a.m. The following trustees were present: Warren Carson, Chairman; Ron Giles, Jimmy Tanner, Grady Franklin, David Herndon, Pat Morgan, and Ron Paris. The following County Commissioners were present: Chivous Bradley, Chairman; Charles Hill, Paul McIntosh, and Brent Washburn. Others present were: Willard Lewis, Stephen Matheny, Glenda Scruggs, Mike Gavin, John Condrey, Judy Toney, Paula Roach, Julie Scherer and Hazel Haynes. Pam Bunch with **The Daily Courier** was also present.

President Lewis presented the local budget for 2007-2008 to the Board of Commissioners. The total budget request is \$1,882,370 which represents a \$270,914 or 17.38% increase over the budget for 2005-06. Dr. Lewis stated that the largest increase in the budget request is in the fuel and heating line item. The allocation last year was \$185,000. This year it increases to \$345,000. Electricity was \$325,000 last year. This year it increases to \$370,000. These amounts are based upon actual usage figures.

Stephen Matheny reported that the college began to notice that the therm usage in some of the buildings tripled during the winter months while traffic did not increase and the winter was mild. Mr. Matheny stated that he was working with Public Service Gas of North Carolina to determine if there is a problem with the lines or equipment. Mr. Matheny stated that PSNC will bring in technicians to check the buildings and determine if there is a problem with their equipment.

Dr. Lewis stated that there is also a 3.5% cost-of-living increase built into the budget for insurance, salaries and related expenses. Dr. Lewis further stated that if it were not for the increase in fuel and heating, the actual budget increase would only be 3.15%.

Mr. Bradley thanked President Lewis and the Trustees for their attendance at the budget meeting and assured them that the county would take the college's request into consideration.

The meeting was adjourned at 12:25 p.m.
